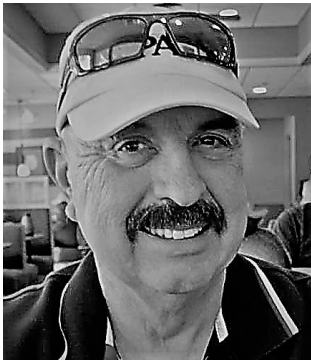

Use your NOAA weather alert radio to monitor for hazardous weather. Some Airstreamers use cell phone apps, such as Storm Shield, Accuweather, Wx Alert USA, The Weather Channel or My Radar. For Emergency weather alerts through Nixle Public Safety, text 49829 to 888777. You will receive weather alerts on your phone. To turn off, text STOP to 88877. Text messaging rates from your provider may apply. **Use your best judgment about leaving the awning on your Airstream out while away from your rig**

The Amvets Hall on Lincoln between 14th Ave. N and 13 Ave. N is open to all Airstream Veterans, be they VFW, Amvet, American Legion, DAV. All vets may drop in, enjoy their hospitality, meals and entertainment.

In an effort to create a pedestrian friendly zone as well as create space for the Airstream trailer display and food vendors, the blacktop area between the grandstand and the Ruth Butler building is now a **No Parking Zone** and is blocked off to all vehicle traffic. In addition, the main gate into this area will be closed. The side entrance to campground parking will be open. Personal vehicle event parking will be located behind the Friendship Center #2 (in the field outside the fence). Use the pedestrian gate to enter the fairgrounds for access to all activities. Handicap parking will be between the Ruth Butler Building #3 and the Youth Building #4. Handicap placard must be displayed. Enter this area from 14th Ave N behind the Ruth Butler Building.
